## What is it like to live in Crawley?



**Year 3 - Spring Term 2026**

**This term we are focusing the majority of our learning on a geographic topic based on developing an area of Crawley. Our learning will begin with looking at maps, their symbols and the importance of a key.**

**The children will be able to locate places on a map and use fieldwork and observational skills to understand a locality.**

**They will develop their knowledge of Crawley, present findings using annotated sketches, simple scaled drawings and appropriate terminology.**

**Here is some information to help you support your child's learning throughout the Spring Term.**

### **You could help your child at home by...**

- *Encouraging your child to read regularly and discussing their reading with them.*
- *Visit areas of Crawley together- the town centre, St Johns' Church, Tilgate Park and Goffs Park.*
- *Find out more about the Crawley neighbourhoods by researching online.*
- *Visit Crawley library to share some books together*
- *Encouraging your child to learn any spellings and/or tricky words which they are given.*
- *Practise recall of times tables. Focus on the times table which your child has been given to learn.  
Use Times Tables Rockstars or Hit the Button to help.*
- *Finding ways to practise maths around the home everyday – in baking, counting, with money or measuring.*
