**This term we are focusing our learning on natural and man-made disasters, how we impact the environment and how we can make changes to limit the impact we have. We will be considering this both from a geographical perspective and through our text, 'Swimming Against the Storm'.**

**We will be learning about how natural and man-made disasters occur, including developing their understanding of geology and global systems. They will use globes and maps to spot patterns.**

**Here is some information to help you support your child's learning throughout the Spring Term.**

**You could help your child at home by...**

- *Encouraging your child to read regularly, particularly their AR books, and discussing their reading with them.*
- *Turn on subtitles!*
- *Using the internet to make independent enquiry about man-made and natural disasters, or even to find out more about the setting for our book, Louisiana.*
- *Encouraging your child to learn any spellings which they are given.*
- *Practising quick recall of times tables. Focus on the multiplication facts that your child has not yet quite secured. Use Times Tables Rockstars or Hit the Button to help.*
- *Using the internet or providing support to practise maths that your child has not yet secured – we have discussed this in school YouTube is a great resource for this.*
