### English

During the Summer Term, we will be writing a setting description inspired by *The Secret of Black Rock* and then a recount of a visit to the beach. We will be focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops correctly and making our writing more exciting by using conjunctions such as 'and' and interesting adjectives. We will also be writing poems and ending the year writing a story inspired by *Paddington*.

### Art - Drawing

Through pencil drawing we will begin to explore the use of line, shape and pattern. We will use objects to inspire observational drawings. We will be looking at the artists Quentin Blake and Rodger Hargreaves.

### Music

Listening to your imagination - finding the pulse, clapping rhythms and singing.

### Maths

In Maths, we will have a large focus on multiplication and division. We will then be looking at fractions and position/direction before building on our existing knowledge of numbers within 50 and looking at place value within 100. Towards the end of the term, we will focus on money and time. We will learn to show 'o'clock' and 'half past' times.

### History

This term we will be comparing old and new types of transport. Creating a vehicle time line to show how these have changed. We will be having a 'Wheels Day' to introduce the topic.

### Geography

We will look at the human (town, village, port, shop, harbour) and physical (beach, cliff, coast, sea, ocean) features found at the coast. We will create our own 3D map to embed our learning.
