This term our history focus will be exploring transport over time. In our Geography learning, we will focus on physical features of the coastline including the beach, cliffs, coast, sea and ocean.

You could enrich your child's life experiences by...

- Taking a bus or train journey to Gatwick, Brighton or London.
- Ride your bike or scooter (remember to wear your helmet!)
- Visiting the Bluebell Railway
- Visiting Brooklands Museum or Mercedes World
- Visiting Shoreham Airport
- Visiting the beach

At home, please continue to...

- *Listen and encourage your child to read every day and discuss their reading with them.*
- *Read to your child and share stories together.*
- *Practise recall of number bonds to 10 and 20.*
- *Find ways to practise maths around the home every day – look for 2D and 3D shapes, measuring with a ruler, telling the time, using coins and paper money and recite the days of the week/months of the year in order. Weigh ingredients for baking & cooking.*
- *Encourage your child to develop their independence - using a knife & fork, carry their own belongings to school, remember to bring water bottle and reading book to school every day. This will stand them in good stead for Year 2.*
