This term we are focusing the majority of our learning on a history topic, Ancient Egypt. We will be using our skills as historians to investigate the evidence that tells us how the Ancient Egyptians lived, why they built the pyramids and the impact of Ancient Egypt on our modern world.

We hope to have an Egyptian workshop for the children in June. (TBC) We also plan to host our own museum to present all our learning about Ancient Egypt.

Here is some information to help you support your child's learning throughout the Summer Term.

You could help your child at home by...

- *Encouraging your child to read regularly and discussing their reading with them.*
- *Reading to your child and sharing stories together*
- *Using the internet for resources and information about the Ancient Egyptians*
- *Encouraging your child to learn any spellings and/or tricky words which they are given.*
- *Practise recall of times tables. Focus on the times table which your child has been given to learn.

- *Finding ways to practise maths around the home everyday – in baking, counting, with money or measuring.*
